O P I N I O N

Application 7546 was filed with the Division of Water Resources on
May 2, 1933 by W. W. Goff. It was completed in accordance with the Water Commission
Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Division of Water Resources and after being
duly advertised was protested by Maude Welden, H. S. Lee, Cora Lee, W. W. Bell and
H. W. Egbert. No answers to the protests were filed and recent correspondence

addressed to applicant has met with no response.

In order that the files of this office might be cleared in the matter Application 7546 was set for a public hearing in accordance with Section 1a of the Water Commission Act on Tuesday, May 8, 1934 at 10:00 o'clock A.M. in Room 401, Public Works Building, Sacramento, California. Of this hearing applicant and protestant were duly notified. Accompanying the notice of hearing was a letter addressed to the protestant, a copy of which was sent to the applicant stating that inasmuch as applicant had failed to respond to recent correspondence it was assumed that the project had been abandoned and this office would be governed accordingly unless an appearance was made on his behalf at the hearing. Protestants were further advised that in the event that applicant indicated an intention to appear, the place of hearing would be transferred to Quincy to meet the convenience of all interested parties and that notice of such transfer would be sent to them in sufficient time for them to be represented. The protestants were further advised that there would be no need of their appearance at Sacramento.

Although applicant received a copy of the notice of hearing and also a copy of the letter sent to the protestant; no appearance was made on his behalf at the hearing nor has there been shown any cause for failure to appear. It is therefore the opinion of this office that applicant has no further interest in the matter and that the proposed project under Application 7546 has in fact been abandoned. Application 7546 should therefore be cancelled.

O R D E R

Application 7546 for a permit to appropriate water having been filed with the Division of Water Resources as above stated, protests having been filed, a public hearing having been held at which no appearance was made on behalf of the applicant and no cause shown for failure to appear and it appearing to the Division that Application 7546 has been abandoned.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application 7546 be rejected and cancelled upon the records of the Division of Water Resources.
