## STATE OF CALIFORNIA STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD

In the Matter of Application 21541 of Twin Lakes Park Company to Appropriate from Devil Canyon (Canada de Los Alisos) in Los Angeles County

Decision 1327

## DECISION DENYING APPLICATION

Twin Lakes Park Company having filed Application 21541 for a permit to appropriate unappropriated water; a protest having been received; the applicant and protestant having stipulated to proceedings in lieu of hearing as provided for by Title 23, California Administrative Code, Section 737; an investigation having been made by the State Water Resources Control Board pursuant to said stipulation; the Board, having considered all available information, finds as follows:

1. Application 21541 is for a permit to appropriate 15,000 gallons per day by direct diversion from January 1 to December 31 of each year for domestic purposes from Devil Canyon (Canada de Los Alisos) in Los Angeles County. The point of diversion is to be located within the  $NW^{\frac{1}{4}}$  of  $NE^{\frac{1}{4}}$ , Section 7, T2N, R16W, SBB&M.

2. Applicant proposes to pump water from two wells (Wells Nos. 1 and 4) to serve the domestic needs of 150 homes within the place of use.

3. Geologic investigations indicate that the only water obtainable from Wells Nos. 1 and 4 is percolating groundwater and not the underflow of Canada de Los Alisos or water from a known underground channel.

4. No permit is required from this Board to pump percolating groundwater.

5. As of January 28, 1968, the applicant ceased to serve water to the proposed place of use. All water is now delivered to the proposed place of use by the Las Virgenes Municipal Water District.

From the foregoing findings the Board concludes that Application 21541 should be denied.

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application 21541 be, and it is, denied.
