DECLARATION OF JEANNE M. ZOLEZZI

I, Jeanne M. Zolezzi, declare as follows:

- 1. I am an attorney, duly licensed to practice law in the State of California.
- 2. I have been the general counsel for Solano County Water Agency ("Agency") since its formation in 1989.
- 3. The Settlement Agreement entered into on May 23, 2000 among the Agency, City of Davis, Putah Creek Council and the Regents of the University of California anticipated that the Agency, on behalf of the Solano parties, would request that the Bureau of Reclamation file Petitions for Change with the State Water Resources Control Board in order to conform the water right permits held by Reclamation for the Solano Project to the Amended Judgments.
- 4. When developing the language for those petitions, the parties realized that while they had agreed to refrain from enforcement action through the courts under certain circumstances, they had not agreed to refrain from enforcement action through the State Water Resources Control Board under those same circumstances.
- 5. The parties determined that it was in their best interest to clarify such intention, while at the same time clarifying further the circumstances under which such enforcement action could be taken.
- 6. The Stipulation entered into among the parties dated June 18, 2002 is intended to accomplish clarification of enforcement action, and apply the restraint of enforcement provision to both the court and the State Water Resources Control Board.
