Notice is hereby given that East Sanel Irrigation Company (East Sanel), Middleridge Vineyards, M-R Vineyard, and Brutocao Vineyards have filed applications for water right permits and/or petition changes. The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) will determine whether water right permits or petition changes should be issued for the applications/petitions and, if so, whether conditions are needed in the permit or license to protect the environment, the public interest, and downstream water users. This notice provides a description of the proposed projects and also describes the procedure and time frame for submittal of protests against these applications and/or petitions. This notice may be viewed at the Division of Water Rights' (Division) website at www.waterrights.ca.gov. BACKGROUND

The applications and petition changes listed in this notice are interconnected. East Sanel is comprised of lands owned by five entities: Middleridge Vineyards, M-R Vineyard, Brutocao Vineyards, Lakeview Vineyards, and University of California. East Sanel diverts water by pumping from the Russian River via a 14-inch pipeline that is approximately 11,400 feet in length to the four entities. Four of the five entities either have existing water rights of their own or have applied for water rights in addition to utilizing water from East Sanel and their applications are outlined in the table shown below. East Sanel is petitioning to increase its place of use under Licensed Application 25596, and Applications 31179, and 31261 to include 935.5 acres that will cover Middleridge Vineyards, M-R Vineyard, Brutocao Vineyards, Lakeview Vineyards, and University of California. In addition, East Sanel is seeking a right under Application 31179 to continue to divert 2.95 cubic feet per second (cfs) from February 15 through March 31 for frost protection purposes and under Application 31261 it is seeking to continue to divert water from November 1 through November 15 by direct diversion for irrigation purposes. Middleridge Vineyards filed Application 31446 to establish a right to continue to store seven acre-feet annually (afa) to storage from December 15 through March 31 of the succeeding year for irrigation, frost protection, and heat control purposes. Of the entities listed above, East Sanel and M-R Vineyard have filed Applications to Appropriate Water by Permit and/or Petition Changes, and Brutocao Vineyards has filed a petition to amend its place of use on two applications that were previously noticed.

The applicant proposes to divert water from the Russian River using an existing diversion facility covered by License 11727 (Application 25596) of East Sanel for irrigation, frost protection and heat control of 425.5 acres of vineyards. Of the 425.5 acres, 165 acres are located on Middleridge Vineyards property and served by pending Application 29783 and Permitted Applications 25887A&B and A25888A&B. License 11727 (Application 25596) of East Sanel and pending Application 30015 of M-R Vineyard list 170 acres on M-R Vineyard lands of the proposed 425.5-acre place of use. Middleridge and M-R Vineyards have petitioned to change the places of use to include the entire 425.5 acres.

The water sought under Application 31296 will add operational flexibility by adding a diversion from the Russian River for water to be stored in Reservoirs Nos. 1, 2, and 3. These reservoirs are also listed in water right Application 30015. Application 30015 requests diversion of 123 acre-feet of water from Dooley Creek to for storage in Reservoir Nos. 1, 2, and 3, and Application 31296 seeks to divert water from the Russian River to store up to 123 acre-feet in the same three reservoirs during the same diversion season as Application 30015. The total maximum amount to be stored under both Applications 30015 and 31296 shall not exceed 123 acre-feet annually. Water will be conveyed to M-R Vineyards via a 14-inch diameter pipeline approximately 11,400 feet in length. The total amount of water diverted by this application together with Applications 25887A&B, 25888A&B, 29783, 30015, 25596 (License 11727), 31179 and 31261 shall not exceed 880 acre-feet per year. Description of Projects - Applications 29760 and 30656

The applications were noticed on April 3, 1998 and protests were received. The protests that are unresolved and remain in good standing include: Trout Unlimited of California, California Sportfishing Protection Alliance, and Department of Fish and Game. The notice dated April,1998 stated the applicant was irrigating 328 acres; however, after an inspection by the Division, it was determined the place of use is 357 acres. The applicant has filed change petitions that request an increase in the place of use to 357 acres.

Background

The applicant has filed two applications as follows: (1) Application 29760 is for direct diversion of 2.95 cfs (not to exceed 385 afa) for irrigation and total storage of 158 afa for irrigation, frost protection, heat control, and incidental recreational purposes and (2) Application 30656 was filed for direct diversion of 2.95 cfs (not to exceed 328 afa) from March 1 through May 15 of each year for frost protection of the irrigated vineyards under Application 29760. The combined amount to be diverted under both applications shall not exceed 543 afa.

Application 29760 has five reservoirs and consists of diverting water from the Russian River (East Sanel's point of diversion) and conveying it via a pipeline to Offstream Reservoir A. The pipeline has a "T" before it reaches Reservoir A that allows the applicant to divert water to Offstream Reservoir B. Reservoirs A and B were constructed in 1972 and 1984, respectively, and irrigate and frost protect the upper portion of the vineyard. Reservoirs Nos. 2 and 3 were constructed in the early 1990s, and Reservoir No. 4 is a pit-type reservoir that has yet to be constructed. Reservoirs Nos. 2, 3, and 4 are onstream and collect water from an unnamed stream tributary to Dooley Creek to irrigate the southern portion of the ranch. Water is also taken from a well located near Offstream Reservoir A for storage and can be pumped up to Reservoirs Nos. 2 and 3. Water can be transported and commingled with waters from Offstream Reservoirs A and B to Reservoirs Nos. 2, 3, and 4.

PROTEST SUBMITTAL INFORMATION

Protest Requirements

A person may file a protest based on any of the following factors:

- Interference with prior water rights.
- Adverse environmental impact.
- Not in the public interest.
- Contrary to law.
- Not within the jurisdiction of the SWRCB.

All protests must clearly describe the objections to approval of the application and the factual basis for those objections. There must be a clear link between the proposed project and the objection to its approval. If the objection is based on interference with prior water rights, the protest must describe specifically what injury would result if the application is approved. In addition, the party claiming interference with prior rights must provide specific information describing the basis of the prior right, the date the use began, the quantity of water used, the purpose of use and the place of use. Please note that any water right permit issued by the SWRCB is subject to vested water rights and will include conditions to protect such rights.

If the protest is based on an allegation that the proposed appropriation would not be within the SWRCB's jurisdiction, would not best conserve the public interest or public trust uses, would have an adverse environmental impact, or would be contrary to law, the protest must be accompanied by a statement of facts supporting the allegation.

For example, public interest protests should clearly indicate how the appropriation will affect the public; environmental protests should identify specific impacts and provide supporting recitals on the effect of the proposed project on plants, animals, fish, erosion, pollution, aesthetics, etc.; public trust protests must identify the navigable waters and public trust values that would be affected by the proposed project and how the project will impact public trust values.

All protests should include a description of any measures that could be taken to resolve the protest. The protest also must indicate the manner in which the protestant served upon the applicant a duplicate copy of the protest.

If sufficient information is not submitted, the SWRCB may reject the protest or request that the protestant submit additional information. Protests of a general nature (not project specific) or protests that are inconsistent with constitutional or legislated state policy will not be accepted. A request for information or a request that studies be conducted does not constitute a protest.

Procedure for Submitting Protests

Protests should be submitted on standard protest forms available from the Division's website at www.waterrights.ca.gov/forms/ or upon request, in writing or by telephone, from the Division. A pamphlet that provides additional information relating to water rights and the procedure for filing protests is also available on the website or by mail. Any requests or the submittal of the completed protest form should be directed to the individual listed as the contact person at the end of this notice. A copy of the completed protest form must also be mailed to the applicant.

Protest Submittal Deadline

Protests submitted in response to this notice must be received by the Division by 3:00 p.m. on the **40**th day after the date of this notice (the close of the protest period). Protests may be submitted by any of the following methods:

- 2. Faxed to the Division at (916) 341-5400
- 3. E-mailed to the engineer listed below under the heading "Contact Person"
- 4. Hand-delivered to the Division office located at 1001 "I" Street, 14th Floor, Sacramento, CA

If you choose to fax or e-mail the protest due to the constraints of the noticing period, the fax or e-mail must be followed by timely delivery of an original signed copy, either personally or by mail, to the Division in order for the protest to be accepted. The SWRCB will respond to all protests within 60 days of the final day to file a protest. **Protests not submitted by the close of the protest period will be subject to rejection.**

For good cause, the SWRCB may grant an extension of time to file a protest. It is the protestant's responsibility to contact the engineer listed below as "Contact Person" to request the extension prior to the end of the protest period.

Resolution of Protests

The applicant will have 30 days to respond to a protest once it is accepted by the Division. The protestant and the applicant are expected to make a good faith effort to resolve the protest within 180 days from the close of the protest period.

This is a "minor" project (the proposed diversion is 3 cubic feet per second or less by direct diversion or 200 acre-feet or less per year by storage) as defined by section 1348 of the Water Code. Therefore, any protest issues not resolved by the applicant or by provisions of section 1335 of the Water Code will be decided by the Chief, Division of Water Rights, following a field investigation.
