

- 4. A <u>ten</u> year extension of time is requested to complete construction work and/or beneficial use of water. (Indicate a period of time less than or equal to 10 years. Must be consistent with the time frame allowed in (California Code of Regulations sections 840 through 844)
- 5. How much water has been used? 8.4 acre-feet/year
- 6. How many acres have been irrigated? Six acres of trees are currently being irrigated.
- 7. How many houses or people have been served water? None.
- 8. Extent of past use of water for any other purpose. <u>Currently, the water is used solely for irrigation purposes.</u>
- 9. What construction work has been completed during the last extension? None.
- 10. Approximate amount spent on project during last extension period. \$ 6,000 on engineering consultants and a new submersible pump.
- 11. Estimate date construction work will be completed. Unknown at this time.
- 12. Estimated year in which water will be fully used. Within 3 years of completion of the project under permit number 20682.
- 13. Reasons why construction and/or use of water were not completed within time previously allowed. A reservoir has been constructed ("Existing Reservoir"). In 1985, however, it was discovered that actual capacity of the Upper Reservoir as constructed is 1.1 acre-feet less than the amount approved under permit number 17822. The Existing Reservoir has not been expanded to the 9.5 acre-feet storage capacity authorized under Permit No. 17822 because in the past, adjacent landowners had allowed the permit holder to divert water from the Existing Reservoir to a larger reservoir on the adjacent property, and then pump the water for irrigation. The current adjacent landowner no longer allows this practice and an expanded reservoir is needed on site to meet permit holder's irrigation needs. Once an extension of time is granted for permit numbers 17822 and 20685, a larger reservoir will be constructed. The larger reservoir will consume the Existing Reservoir and enable the permit holder to make full use of the water allocated under permit numbers 17822 and 20685.

If the use of water is for municipal (including industrial) and irrigation supplies and is provided or regulated by public agencies and use of the water has commenced, but additional time is needed to reach full use contemplated, the following information must be provided. Not Applicable
