Dear Mr. Emanuel:

Enclosed is a small map of the Patianna Ranch. I have marked each of the existing and proposed pump locations on the ranch with a handwritten number and a pink dot. The following is what my client wishes to do with each of these locations.

- #1 Irrigation well at GPS location N495,422' and E1,680,032'. This well will be used both for irrigation and frost protection. My understanding is that the well is currently authorized for use under the irrigation license #9854. In the attached amendment we propose to add that location as a P.O.D. to the frost protection application #31085.
- 3 Frank Rosewan #2 River pump station at GPS location N495,094' and E1,679,912'. This station is to be added as a new P.O.D. for the irrigation license #9854. Funderstand that this location is already included in the frost protection application #31085.
- #8 Old river pump location at GPS location N494,244' and E1,680,275'. I understand that this is covered by the irrigation license #9854. My client intends to keep this location as an authorized P.O.D. for both the license and the frost protection application. Therefore, we enclose an amendment to add it as a P.O.D. to the frost protection application. My client will use this location periodically to maintain it as an approved location for a P.O.D.

This is the domestic well at GPS location N494,520' and E1,680,905'. This well does not pump underflow of the Russian River but rather pumps from other subterranean water underlying this property. This well is used for supplying water to the houses only. My client's use is riparian in nature, and he is filing herewith a statement of such use.

#5 Proposed new well. My client proposes to drill a new well at this location approximately 100 feet east of point #5 referred to above and to add it as a P.O.D. to both the irrigation license and frost protection application.

#6 To make sure that all of the property in the vineyard is included in the place of use of the license we submit herewith a petition to change the place of use to include all of the property west of East Side Road in the GPS coordinates referred to in your letter of May 29, 2002, item 3, i.e., 75.3 acres.
