NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION 48

COUNTY: Colusa STREAM SYSTEM: Lurline Creek

Maxwell Public Utilities District, P.O. Box 294, Maxwell, CA 95955 has filed a wastewater change petition, seeking to change the purpose of use and place of use of treated wastewater to use up to 0.2 million gallons per day [0.31 cubic foot per second (cfs)] for irrigation of 120 net acres within a 264 acre site within the W½ of the NE¼ and the NW¼ of Section 9, T16N, R3E, MDB&M.

The District historically discharged treated wastewater effluent into an agricultural ditch that is tributary to an unnamed stream that drains into Lurline Creek, and has chosen an alternative for its wastewater disposal. The District will discontinue its surface water discharge and instead direct its wastewater discharge to an offsite storage pond where it will then be used for agricultural irrigation of non-edible crops.
