NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION 49

COUNTY: Merced STREAM SYSTEM: Miles Creek

Planada Community Services District, c/o Daniel Chavez, 103 Live Oak Street, P.O. Box 905, Planada, CA 95365 has filed a wastewater change petition, seeking to change the point of diversion, purpose of use and place of use of treated wastewater to use 0.527 cubic foot per second (cfs) for irrigation of 341 acres within N ½ of Section 4, T8S, R15E, MDB&M; S ½ of SW ¼ of Section 33, T7S, R15E, MDB&M; SW ¼ of Section 33, T7S, R15E, MDB&M.

The District historically discharged treated wastewater effluent into Miles Creek and has chosen an alternative for wastewater disposal. The District will discontinue its surface water discharge and instead direct its wastewater discharge to land disposal in percolation ponds during the winter months to be later used for agricultural irrigation during the spring and summer months.
