The proposed project involves expanding the "place of use" for Permit 20905 to reflect the current service area boundary of the permit holder (Russian River County Water District). The expansion areas are already developed and served by existing infrastructure. Water diversion under Permit 20905 will increase by approximately 20 acre feet and will remain significantly below the amount authorized. There will be no charge in to the existing rate of diversion as the existing diversion facilities (offset wells) will be utilized without any modifications thereto. The water is and will continue to be used for municipal purposes.



Additional Environmental Information

The District's water supply wells were constructed in 1986. At that time, the District obtained a Streambed Alteration Agreement (Notification No. 1058D, attached). Wells were constructed in accordance with that Agreement. Expanding the Place of Use for Permit 20905 will not alter the well site or the permitted pumping rate. No physical changes are proposed.

The District prepared an Initial Study/Negative Declaration that assessed the petition for expanding the Place of Use for Permit 20905 in July 2008 (attached). Comments received were limited to those from the Department of Fish and Game and the Division of Water Rights. Comments and responses to comments are contained in the attached Appendix A, Response to Comments document. The District subsequently adopted a Negative Declaration for the project on October 28, 2008. A Notice of Determination was filed at the State Clearinghouse and Sonoma County Clerk on October 30, 2008, including payment of the CDFG filing fee (copies attached).

Attached photos show the two existing well sites and conditions of the Russian River upstream and downstream perpendicular of the well field location. Development in the proposed expanded Place of Use is characteristic of residential development in the existing Place of Use and the west Russian River corridor in general.
