Petition for Change

Petition for Extension of Time

Before the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) can approve a petition to change your water right permit or a petition for extension of time to complete use, the SWRCB must consider the information contained in an environmental document prepared in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). This form is not a CEQA document. If a CEQA document has not yet been prepared, a determination must be made of who is responsible for its preparation. As the petitioner, you are responsible for all costs associated with the environmental evaluation and preparation of the required CEQA documents. Please answer the following questions to the best of your ability and submit any studies that have been conducted regarding the environmental evaluation of your project. If you need more space to completely answer the questions, please number and attach additional sheets.

The McCanna Ranch Water Company ("McCanna Water") submits this change petition to the State Water Resources Control Board ("SWRCB") pursuant to Water Code section 1700 *et seq* to amend the number of, and descriptions for, the points of diversion in Application No. 30503. On January 11, 1996, McCanna Water submitted its Application to the SWRCB. The Application included a description of one existing and two proposed points of diversion. Today four wells are used to divert water from an unnamed subterranean stream. All four wells are located within the service area. Pursuant to the SWRCB's request, McCanna Water is now amending its Application to include the California Coordinates for each of the four points of diversion.

The proposed amendment will not alter current water service operations nor result in any increases in the annual diversions. No new construction, grading or excavation is necessary to complete the proposed change to the Application. The change will not effect current land uses.


