NOTICE OF PETITION TO CHANGE PERMIT 20281 (APPLICATION 30358) OF WOODLAND-DAVIS CLEAN WATER AGENCY

COUNTY: YOLO STREAM SYSTEM: SACRAMENTO RIVER

On June 21, 2016, the Woodland-Davis Clean Water Agency (WDCWA or Petitioner) filed a change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division) requesting approval of changes to water right Permit 20281 (Application 30358) pursuant to Chapter 10 of Part 2 of Division 2 of the Water Code. With the petition, WDCWA seeks authorization to deliver up to 5,700 acre-feet of surface water annually diverted under Permit 20281 to the newly developed City of Woodland aquifer storage and recovery (ASR) program. Under the ASR program, surface water will be stored during periods when excess treated surface water is available for injection into and storage in the groundwater aquifer under the City of Woodland in the Yolo Sub-basin of the Sacramento Valley Groundwater Basin for eventual use within the City of Woodland.
