NOTICE OF AMENDED PETITIONS FOR EXTENSION OF TIME PERMITS 7847, 8594, AND 11039 (APPLICATIONS 13217, 14068, AND 17121)

COUNTY: Sonoma STREAM SYSTEM: Russian River

The City of Healdsburg (City or Petitioner) filed petitions for a 10-year extension of time on June 3, 1992 for Permit 8594 and November 7, 2002 for Permits 7847 and 11039. The petitions were previously noticed by the Division on July 17, 1992 for Permit 8594 and January 28, 2005 for Permits 7847 and 11039. On April 29, 2016, the City amended the petitions for extension of time to request additional time to put water to full beneficial use under its permits. The City has requested an extension of time to December 31, 2030, which is consistent with the City's General Plan. No other changes are being requested.
