NOTICE OF PETITIONS FOR CHANGE FOR WATER RIGHT PERMIT 20820 (APPLICATION 30118) OF WILLIAM HARDIN TRUST

COUNTY: Napa STREAM SYSTEM: Pope Creek

On April 13 and 14, 2015, William Hardin Trust (Petitioner) filed petitions to change its water right Permit 20820 (Application 30118) with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division). With the petitions, the Petitioner has requested to modify Permit 20820 as follows: 1) to replace a proposed point of diversion/rediversion at a currently permitted (and unbuilt) onstream reservoir with a new off-stream reservoir; 2) to allow industrial use as a purpose of use; 3) to modify the place of use to include 33 acres that are outside of the current place of use, and 4) to allow a time extension to complete beneficial use under the permit until December 31, 2026.
