NOTICE OF WASTEWATER CHANGE PETITION WW0099

COUNTY: San Joaquin STREAM SYSTEM: San Joaquin Delta

On February 16, 2017, City of Lodi (City) filed a wastewater change petition (WW0099) with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights pursuant to Water Code section 1211. With the petition, the City seeks authorization to reduce the discharge of treated wastewater into Dredger Cut by up to 552.4 acre-feet per year and direct that water into four storage ponds. The stored water would be used for irrigation on the City's lands.
