NOTICE OF PETITION FOR CHANGE FOR WATER RIGHT PERMIT 11570 (APPLICATION 18055) OF HOWELL MOUNTAIN MUTUAL WATER COMPANY

COUNTY: Napa STREAM SYSTEM: Unnamed Stream tributary to Napa River

On July 6, 2017 the Howell Mountain Mutual Water Company (HMMWC) filed a petition to change Permit 11570 with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights pursuant to Water Code section 1701. HMMWC wishes to add existing Point 8 (Cooksley Lake) as a point of re-diversion for water diverted at Point 7 and change the distribution of storage by adding Cooksley Lake as a place of storage.
