## NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY URGENCY CHANGE FOR WATER RIGHT PERMIT 10477 (APPLICATION 12842) OF NORTH SAN JOAQUIN WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

COUNTY: SAN JOAQUIN STREAM SYSTEM: MOKELUMNE RIVER


EFFECTIVE DATE: AUGUST 20, 2009 TO FEBRUARY 28, 2010

North San Joaquin Water Conservation District, c/o Karna Harrigfeld, Herum Crabtree Attorneys, 2291 West March Lane, Suite B100, Stockton, CA 95207, has filed a Petition for Temporary Urgency Change to temporarily modify a condition of its permit that limits the quantity of water that can be diverted to underground storage. With the petition, the District requests the maximum quantity of water diverted to underground storage be increased from 1,000 acre-feet annually (afa) to 2,000 afa. This will not increase the total amount of water that can be diverted under Permit 10477.
