NOTICE OF PETITIONS FOR LONG-TERM TRANSFER AND INSTREAM FLOW DEDICATION FROM MERCED IRRIGATION DISTRICT TO U.S. BUREAU OF RECLAMATION UNDER LICENSE 2685 (APPLICATION 1224) IN MERCED AND MARIPOSA COUNTIES

MERCED AND MARIPOSA STREAM SYSTEM: MERCED RIVER

On December 16, 2011, Merced Irrigation District (MID) filed a petition for long-term transfer pursuant to Water Code section 1735 et seq., and a petition for instream flow dedication pursuant to Water Code section 1707, for water right License 2685 (Application 1224). The water will be used to assist the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) in meeting the 31-day pulse flow period in the San Joaquin River at Vernalis during April and May of 2012 and 2013. The pulse flows are proposed as an interim measure between the expiration of the San Joaquin River Agreement (SJRA) and the State Water Resources Control Board's adoption of new flow objectives for the San Joaquin River. MID filed the petitions in order to provide continued pulse flows in April and May, similar to the pulse flows that would have been provided under the SJRA, with certain exceptions, during 2012 and 2013. The proposed changes include the continued place of use and purpose of use for these pulse flows. Proposed Additional Purpose of Use During Transfer/Dedication	Fish and Wildlife Enhancement through December 31, 2013
Place of Use	Domestic and irrigation use on 164,395 gross acres within the MID boundaries; Municipal use to 1,900 acres known as the Mariposa Town Planning Area; Irrigation use on 9,418.6 acres within the El Nido Irrigation District boundaries; and fish and wildlife enhancement temporarily allowed within the reaches of the Merced River and San Joaquin River between MID's existing point of diversion at New Exchequer Dam and Vernalis through December 31, 2011.
Proposed Place of Use During Transfer/Dedication	MID proposes to continue temporary fish and wildlife enhancement (as modified by the petitions) from New Exchequer Dam to Vernalis through December 31, 2013.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 814, any interested party may file a protest against this petition. Comments must be received by the Division of Water Rights by 4:30 p.m. on January 23, 2012. A copy must also be provided to the petitioner at the address above.
