NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE INVOLVING THE TRANSFER OF UP TO 6,000 ACRE-FEET OF WATER FROM MERCED IRRIGATION DISTRICT TO MERCED IRRIGATION DISTRICT'S SPHERE OF INFLUENCE LANDS UNDER LICENSE 2685 (APPLICATION 1224) IN MERCED COUNTY

On June 10, 2011, Merced Irrigation District (MID) filed a petition for temporary change to transfer up to 6,000 acrefeet of water pursuant to Water Code section 1725 et seq., under water right License 2685 (Application 1224). The water will be transferred to MID's Sphere of Influence Lands (SOI Lands) which are located in Merced County. MID proposes to transfer water stored under its License 2685 to irrigate land that is currently not included as a place of use under the license. The proposed change will include the addition of 40,447 acres within a gross area of 71,540 acres for irrigation. Temporary changes under Water Code section 1725 may be effective for a period of up to one year.
