NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE INVOLVING THE TRANSFER OF UP TO 10,000 ACRE-FEET OF WATER FROM MERCED IRRIGATION DISTRICT TO WESTLANDS WATER DISTRICT UNDER LICENSE 2685 (APPLICATION 1224) IN MERCED COUNTY

COUNTY: MERCED STREAM SYSTEM: MERCED RIVER

On July 2, 2012, Merced Irrigation District (MID) filed a petition for temporary change to transfer up to 10,000 acre feet of water pursuant to Water Code section 1725 et seq., under water right License 2685 (Application 1224). The water will be transferred to Westlands Water District. The proposed change will include the addition of the Central Valley Project place of use in order to facilitate the transfer to Westlands. Temporary changes under Water Code section 1725 may be effective for a period of up to one year.
