NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE INVOLVING THE TRANSFER OF UP TO 8,000 ACRE-FEET OF WATER FROM CONAWAY PRESERVATION GROUP TO SAN LUIS AND DELTA-MENDOTA WATER AUTHORITY UNDER LICENSE 5487B (APPLICATION 12073B)

COUNTY: YOLO STREAM SYSTEM: SACRAMENTO RIVER

On May 6, 2013, Conaway Preservation Group (Conaway) filed a petition for temporary change to transfer up to 8,000 acre feet of water pursuant to Water Code section 1725 et seq., under water right License 5487B (Application 12073B). The water will be transferred to the San Luis and Delta-Mendota Water Authority via groundwater substitution. With the petition, Conaway requests to: (1) add the Central Valley Project's (CVP) CW "Bill" Jones Pumping Plant and the State Water Project's (SWP) Harvey O. Banks Pumping Plant as points of diversion, and (2) add the service area of the CVP as an additional place of use under Conaway's License 5487B. Temporary changes under Water Code section 1725 may be effective for a period of up to one year.
