NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE INVOLVING THE TRANSFER OF UP TO 1,730 ACRE-FEET OF WATER FROM PELGER MUTUAL WATER COMPANY TO SAN LUIS & DELTA-MENDOTA WATER AUTHORITY UNDER LICENSE 8547B (APPLICATION 12470B)

COUNTY: SUTTER STREAM SYSTEM: SACRAMENTO RIVER

On April 30, 2013, Pelger Mutual Water Company (PMWC) filed a petition for temporary change to transfer up to 1,730 acre feet of water pursuant to Water Code section 1725 et seq., under water right License 8547B (Application 12470B). The water will be transferred to San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority. The proposed change will include the addition of (1) the Central Valley Project's (CVP) CW "Bill" Jones Pumping Plant and the State Water Project's Harvey O. Banks Pumping Plant as points of diversion; and (2) add the service area of the CVP to the place of use. Temporary changes under Water Code section 1725 may be effective for a period of up to one year.
