## NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY URGENCY CHANGE FOR PERMIT 20387 (APPLICATION 28158)

COUNTY: San Luis Obispo STREAM SYSTEM: Santa Rosa Creek

Cambria Community Services District (Petitioner) has filed a temporary urgency change petition, pursuant to Water Code section 1435, with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division). Due to severe drought conditions, the petition requests to temporarily reduce the monitoring well level at which diversion under Permit 20387 is allowed. Source:	Santa Rosa Creek (Underflow) tributary to the Pacific Ocean
Points of Diversion:	1) Well SR1: SW ¼ of NW ¼ of Section 26, T27S, R8E, MDB&M 2) Well SR2: NE¼ of NW ¼ of Section 26, T27S, R8E, MDB&M 3) Well SR3: NE¼ of NW ¼ of Section 26, T27S, R8E, MDB&M 4) Well SR4: SE¼ of SE ¼ of Section 23, T27S, R8E, MDB&M
Amount:	2.67 cubic feet per second by direct diversion, maximum not to exceed 260 acre feet from May 1 to October 31 or 518 acre-feet per calendar year
Monitoring Well level:	Present: 3 feet above mean sea level Proposed: 2 feet above mean sea level
Season:	January 1 to December 31 of each year
Purpose of Use:	Municipal
Place of Use:	Within the boundaries of the Cambria Community Services District
