NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY URGENCY CHANGE FOR PERMIT 20952 (APPLICATION 29408)

COUNTY: Ventura STREAM SYSTEM: Conejo Creek

The City of Thousand Oaks (Petitioner) has filed a temporary urgency change petition, pursuant to Water Code section 1435, with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division). The petition requests to temporarily reduce the minimum bypass flow requirement in Permit 20952 due to current severe drought conditions.
