Petition of Temporary Change under - Water Code sections 1725-1732

Foresthill Public Utility District (FPUD) proposes to transfer 2,000 acre-feet (AF) of water currently stored in Sugar Pine Reservoir on North Shirttail Canyon Creek to Kern County Water Agency (KCWA) and Dudley Ridge Water District (DRWD) for use to meet existing demand from existing development within the KCWA and DRWD existing service areas. The California Department of Water Resources (DWR), KCWA and DRWD propose to execute an Article 55 agreement for a total of 2,000 AF of FPUD water to be conveyed through existing federal and state facilities.

To accomplish this transfer, the following temporary changes in the place of use and points of re-diversion under FPUD Sugar Pine Reservoir water right permit are needed:
