## NOTICE OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE INVOLVING THE TRANSFER OF UP TO 20,000 ACRE FEET OF WATER FROM MERCED IRRIGATION DISTRICT TO VARIOUS AGENCIES UNDER LICENSE 2685 (APPLICATION 1224)

On May 17, 2019, Merced Irrigation District (Merced) filed a petition for temporary change to transfer up to 20,000 acre-feet of water pursuant to Water Code section 1725 et seq., under water right License 2685 (Application 1224). The proposed change will include the addition of the following to License 2685 in order to supply stored surface water to agricultural lands located near the boundaries of Merced's authorized place of use: Le Grand-Athlone Water District, Lone Tree Mutual Water Company, East Side Water District, Turner Island Water District, Chowchilla Water District, the lands in an area known as the Red Top Area, and the lands in an area known as Merced's Sphere of Influence Lands as proposed places of use.
