Subject: Update to the Bay-Delta Plan

Dear Madam Chair and Members of the Board:

I am not one to usually get involved in these types of issues. But this issue I find particularly troubling.

The Boards current plan seems to dismiss the harm that it will do the people of the Central Valley, It has failed, to look at water quality for the residence living in the Valley, the economic damage and overall quality of life. Many cities and county's are already struggling to maintain water quality in the area, and you just want to take more water from them without addressing the pressing need of how to fix the problems. You look to possibly solve one issue while creating a multitude of other issues.

The short sightedness of the Boards approach focus's only on the water. I understand that all you can control is the water. But the larger picture is the Water Board should be working with other State Agencies , such as Fish and Wildlife to try and come up with a comprehensive solution to the issue. Predatory fish for example. It seems the Board is more concerned with the Fish in the river than the people living around it. The people don't seem to matter and you wont listen to them. You disregard comments as I am sure you will disregard this email.

I ask a simple question, you claim that you want to increase the flow by 40% by taking water the local tributaries, but you also are going to allow two tunnels to be built beneath the Delta to transfer water to Southern CA. How does diverting water under the delta help? It seems to me that if the water flowed through the Delta and was pulled out toward the end of the Delta the health of the water way would be better than the diversion of the water completely around it.
