I believe and I am deeply concerned that the board has significantly underestimated the impact economically to our region that will occur due to the plan amendment requirement of unimpaired river water flows of 40% Feb.-June from the Tuolumne, Stanislaus and Merced rivers.. Our region is already struggling economically and these increased unimpaired water flows of 40% Feb-June I believe will only make the problem much worse economically for our area. I believe the impact to agriculture will be significant. Our region significantly depends on this agriculture economy.
