

Activity Update

- Drought Website Updates (Available Soon)
 - Diversion Demand Data for Priority Watersheds
 - Term 91 Curtailment— Supplemental Project Water Condition
 - Sacramento, San Joaquin, Scott Rivers Supply/Demand Analyses
- Dry Year Report (Released 1/30/2015)
 - In July 2014, the Board required the report by January 31.
 - Analyzed the Board's 2014 Drought Response, reviewed recommendations from a 1978 Drought Report, and provides staff recommendations for improving transparency, data quality and process for 2015, and later, if necessary.
 - Scheduled as Informational Item at Board's Meeting on February 17th.

Activity Update- Continued

- Temporary Urgency Change Petition (TUCP) filed by Bureau and Department
 - Petition received January 23, 2015. Final concurrence letter received on January 30th. Noticed on January 27th.
 - The Executive Director stated he temporarily would not object to operations of the Projects in accordance with the proposed TUC petition. That temporary approval expires today. A final decision and Order is also expected today.
 - Workshop on February 18 to receive public input on Drought Contingency Plan for SWP and CVP and on the TUCP.

Activity Update- Cont.

Other TUCPs and Transfers

Issued

- Department of Water Resources Temporary Transferapproved on January 20th. Transfer allows exchange of 5000 AF between SWP and CVP contractors (Contra Costa WD, Alameda County WD, and Alameda County Flood Control)
- City of Thousand Oaks TUC Renewal- Approved on January 21st.
