Mr. Zomorodi,

I wanted to follow up with you about the Administrative Civil Liability Complaint you received concerning your water right identified as A004383. Unfortunately at this point there are only two options available.

Option 1:

- 1. File the Annual Reports of Licensee for 2016 and 2017 by logging into the State Water Board's website using the Username and Password identified in Username and Password Sheet mailed along with the ACL Complaint, and**
- 2. Pay \$1,000 as payment in full of the Administrative Civil Liability related to the alleged violations described in the ACL Complaint. Payment shall be made by cashier's check, certified check, or money order made payable to the "State Water Resources Control Board," and**

- 3. Properly execute and deliver this Acceptance and Waiver along with the payment to:**

I would say that even though you are past the 20 day deadline, you can submit the \$1,000 payment and management will make a decision on whether or not they are willing to accept a late payment. I would definitely agree, that it is to your benefit to pursue some action (via option 1 or option 2) than to do nothing. Also I want to clarify again, that option 1 requires that all steps 1 to 3 be completed.
