12. On July 27, 2018, the Division mailed out a Notice of Deficiency, warning of the potential for enforcement if the 2016 and 2017 Reports were not submitted.

- 13. On September 17, 2018, the Division mailed out a final Notice of Deficiency, putting You on notice of imminent enforcement should the violation continue.
- 14. As of October 22, 2018, 555 days after the April 1, 2017, and 190 days after the April 1, 2018, deadlines, the 2016 and 2017 Reports have still not been submitted.

PROPOSED CIVIL LIABILITY

- 15. The Board may impose a civil liability of up to \$500 for each day in which the violation occurs for violating a Board regulation. (Water Code section 1846, subd. (a)(2))
- 16. As of October 19, 2018, You have been in violation for 566 days for failing to file the 2016 Report, and 201 days for failing to file the 2017 Report. The maximum liability for the violations alleged is \$383,500 (767 days at \$500/day).
- 17. In determining the appropriate amount of a civil liability, California Water Code section 1848 requires that the Board consider all relevant circumstances, including, but not limited to, the extent of harm caused by the violation, the nature and persistence of the violation, the length of time over which the violation occurs, and the corrective action, if any, taken by the violator.
- 18. In this case, the 2016 Report was due by April 1, 2017, and the 2017 Report was due by April 1, 2018. The value of the data to the public and the Board is tied to its timely submittal, and therefore an increased time lapse between the deadline and the date it is ultimately submitted results increased harm to the regulatory program. The Board's forecasting of water availability during peak water use times of the year, and ability to regulate the resources it is required to protect is diminished by the failure to submit the Report on time. Moreover, the length of time over which the violations has occurred despite repeated attempts to contact You is significant. Finally, the report has not yet been submited: You have made no effort to comply with the regulations.
- 19. Having taken into consideration all relevant circumstances, the Division recommends the imposition of \$3,000 in administrative civil liability (Proposed Liability).

RIGHT TO HEARING

- 20. You may request a hearing on this matter before the State Water Board. Any such request for hearing must be received or postmarked <u>within 20 days</u> of the date that this notice is received as required by Water Code section 1055, subdivision (b).
- 21. If You request a hearing, You will have an opportunity to contest the allegations in this complaint and the imposition of a fine by the Board. The Board will issue a notice setting the specific time and place for the hearing. The hearing notice will be mailed not less than 10 days before the hearing date.
- 22. At the hearing, the Board will consider whether to impose a monetary fine, and if so, whether to adjust the Proposed Liability within the amount authorized by statute. Any Board order imposing an ACL shall be final and effective upon issuance.
- 23. If You do not request a hearing within 20 days, then the right to a hearing on the matter is waived. The Assistant Deputy Director for the Division of Water Rights may then issue a final Administrative Civil Liability Order assessing the Proposed Liability.

YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING:

If you wish to contest the allegations in the Administrative Civil Liability Complaint in person at a hearing before the State Water Board, you must submit a written request **WITHIN THE NEXT 20 DAYS**.

SETTLEMENT OFFER:

The Division is willing to settle this matter without the need for a hearing before the State Water Board, so long as you meet three (3) conditions **WITHIN THE NEXT 20 DAYS**:

- 1. Sign and return the enclosed Acceptance of Settlement Offer;
- 2. Electronically submit the 2016 and 2017 Reports; and
- 3. Pay a Settlement Liability of \$1,000.

IF YOU FAIL TO RESPOND WITHIN 20 DAYS:

If you not respond within the next 20 days by either 1) fulfilling the conditions in the settlement offer or 2) by requesting an in-person hearing on this matter before the State Water Board, then the Division will immediately issue a monetary penalty of \$3,000.



Receipt of this letter constitutes legal service to MICHAEL S DICKEY of the enclosed Administrative Civil Liability Complaint and provides notice of the intent of the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division) to assess a monetary penalty for violating State Water Board regulations.

YOU HAVE <u>20 DAYS</u> TO ACT OR YOU MAY FACE ADDITIONAL FINES AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS. THIS MATTER REQUIRES YOUR IMMEDIATE ATTENTION.

VIOLATION DESCRIPTION:

MICHAEL S DICKEY is required to file an Annual Progress Report by Permittee (Report) by April 1 of each year, and has failed to do so. State Water Board regulations require Reports to be filed by April 1 of the succeeding year for every water right permit. (See Title 23, Chapter 2.7, Article 2, Section 925 of the California Code of Regulations)

MAXIMUM AND PROPOSED PENALTY FOR VIOLATION:

The maximum penalty allowed by law for this type of violation is \$500 per day for every day after the deadline where the report has not been submitted. The State Water Board can impose a fine for failing to submit the annual use report by the deadline (767 days at \$500/day) of up to \$383,500.

The State Water Board is required to consider all relevant circumstance prior to issuing a monetary penalty. The Division has reviewed the relevant circumstances of the case, and has determined that the appropriate proposed liability for failure to file the 2016 and 2017 Reports by April 1, 2017, and April 1, 2018, respectively, is \$3,000.

- MICHAEL S DICKEY, hereinafter refrerred to as "You", is/are alleged to have violated Title 23, Chapter 2.7, Article 2, section 925 of the California Code of Regulations, which requires every water right Permit holder to submit a water diversion and use report by April 1 of each subsequent year for each water right Permit.
- 2. The State Water Resources Control Board (Board) may impose a civil liability of up to \$500 for each day in which the violation of a Board regulation occurs. (Water Code section 1846)
- The Executive Director for the Board may issue an Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Complaint to any person or entity to whom administrative civil liability may be imposed. (Water Code section 1055)
- 4. The Executive Director delegated this authority to the Deputy Director for Water Rights. Pursuant to State Water Board Resolution 2012-0029, the Deputy Director for Water Rights is authorized to issue an order imposing an ACL when a complaint has been issued and no hearing has been requested within 20 days of receipt of the complaint. This authority has been redelegated to the Assistant Deputy Director.

ALLEGATIONS

- 5. The Board adopted the regulation mandating annual water use reporting requirements in 2010, codified in the California Code of Regulations; Title 23, Chapter 2.7, Article 2, section 925.
- 6. The purpose of the regulation is to develop a publicly available database, which allows both the Board and water users access to the information and make informed water management decisions. The value of the database is directly tied the amount and accuracy of information the Board collects through compliance with the regulation.
- 7. Water use information is critical to understanding and planning ahead for limited water supplies, identifying water conservation opportunities, assuring compliance with the quantity and seasonal use limitations of existing water rights, protecting water rights holders' priority of right, and providing for efficient management and use of water during times of shortages.
- 8. You are the owner of record for Permit 21148, and You are required to comply with the annual water diversion and use reporting regulation.
- 9. You failed to submit the 2016 Annual Progress Report by Permittee ("2016 Report") by April 1, 2017.
- 10. In February 2018, the Division of Water Rights mailed out a notice reminding You of the requirement to submit online the 2017 Annual Progress Report by Permittee ("2017 Report") by April 1, 2018, by logging into the electronic Water Rights Information and Management System, with the provided Username and Password.
- 11. You failed to submit the 2017 Report by the April 1, 2018, deadline.
