We request a hearing for three reasons: 1. Reports were completed on 10/22/2018. 2. There are no provisions in the forms for a master meter as all of these rights come off the same spring. 3. Reports were submitted on October 18, 2018 to Lang who advised that they had to be broken down by permit: we submitted as a master meter on domestic use and have yet to hear back if that is an accepted method.
