Permit 7130B (Application 11674B)

Application 11674 filed December 30, 1946 by California Water & Telephone Company, predecessor in ownership California American Water of Monterey Peninsula area water system

Permit 7130 issued July 7, 1948 to California Water & Telephone Company – 19,000 AFA

Permit split in 1984:

Permit 7130A issued May 2, 1984 to California American Water (CAW) – 3,030 AFA (License 11866 issued to CAW under this permit February 14, 1986)

Permit 7130B issued May 2, 1984 to MPWMD – 15,970 AFA

Permit 7130B amended January 6, 1999:

Maximum amount to be appropriated: 15,970 AFA*

Season of collection/diversion: October 1 of each year to May 31 of the succeeding year

34 Points of Diversion and Rediversion along the Carmel River

Permit 20808A (Application 27614A)

Application 27614 filed December 16, 1982

Permit 20808 issued October 25, 2005 – 24,000 AFA by storage; total not to exceed 29,000 AFA

Permit 20808 amended January 6, 1999

Permit 20808A issued November 30, 2007 jointly to MPWMD and California American Water for the Phase 1 Seaside Basin Aquifer Storage and Recovery Project:

Maximum amount to be appropriated: 2,426 AFA*

Maximum diversion rate: 7.7 cfs

Season of collection/diversion: December 1 of each year to May 31 of the succeeding year

27 Points of Diversion to Offstream Storage along the Carmel River

2 Points of Injection and Recovery in the Seaside Groundwater Basin

Permit 20808B (Application 27614B)

Application 27614 filed December 16, 1982

Permit 20808B issued November 30, 2007 – remainder of Permit 20808 quantities after issuance of Permit 20808A:

Maximum amount to be appropriated: total amount of 26,574 AFA* per water year, including a maximum of 21,574 AFA* by storage to be diverted from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Maximum direct diversion rate: 42 cfs

Season of diversion: January 1 to December 31 of each year – however, no water to be diverted outside the diversion season of November 1 of each year to June 30 of the succeeding year until New Los Padres Project becomes fully operational

34 Points of Diversion and Rediversion along the Carmel River
