Petition for Changes to SFA 5648, and Application 31523**

CHANGE TO ORIGINAL NOTICE ISSUED ON MAY 21, 2008

Please note that the changes described below do not change the scope of the hearing as originally noticed. The changes simply provide additional clarification and are being issued upon the June 4, 2008 request of Calaveras County Water District and Northern California Power Agency. **If these changes affect any participant's intent to appear, please inform the State Water Board by Wednesday, June 18.**

remains in effect except for the change noted below:**

1. Key Issue #1a on page five of the Notice is deleted, and the State Water Board will seek evidence to consider the following replacement issue:
 - 1a. Does the Applicants' proposed development conflict with a general or coordinated plan for the development of water that would use SFA 5648?
2. Key Issues #1b and #1c on page five of the Notice are deleted, and the State Water Board will seek evidence to consider the following replacement issue:
 - 1b. Does the Applicants' proposed development conflict with water quality objectives established pursuant to law?

3. Key Issues #1d and #1e on pages five and six of the Notice are deleted, and the State Water Board will seek evidence to consider the following replacement issue:
 - 1c. During Applicants' proposed diversion season, will at least 395 afa of water be physically available in the stream under a priority assigned pursuant to SFA 5648? Alternatively, would water be available under a priority pursuant to Application 31523?
4. Key Issues #1f, #1g, #1h and #1i on page six of the Notice are re-numbered as Key Issues #1d, #1e, #1f and #1g, respectively.


IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS

State Water Board Member Frances Spivy-Weber will preside as hearing officer over this proceeding. Other members of the State Water Board may be present during the hearing (and any pre-hearing conference). State Water Board staff hearing team members will include Staff Counsel Matthew Bullock, Water Resources Control Engineer Ernest Mona, and Environmental Scientist Jane Farwell. The hearing staff will assist the hearing officer and other members of the State Water Board throughout this proceeding.

During the pendency of this proceeding and commencing no later than the issuance of this notice, there shall be no *ex parte* communications between State Water Board members or State Water Board hearing team staff and any of the other participants regarding substantive or controversial procedural matters within the scope of the proceeding.
