Dear Water Board Members:

I wish to address my grave concern re the inequity of the proposed State Water Resources Control Board's Policy AB 2121, especially as it applies to the Gualala River.

The Policy assumes one size fits all and presents no science applicable to the Gualala River watershed nor to pumping from aquifer within this watershed. It would seem reasonable to employ similar science to those found on the South Fork of the Gualala River. The proposed Regional Policy was not validated for the Gualala River, but instead for inland conditions which are far different from ours.

The Sea Ranch has an excellent water conservation record with very low gallons per capita per day; furthermore, the Policy criteria focused on fish and instream flow with no regard for people.

Please do all you can to preserve our water supply so that we do not become a Ghost Town unable to sustain a tax base of considerable magnitude.
