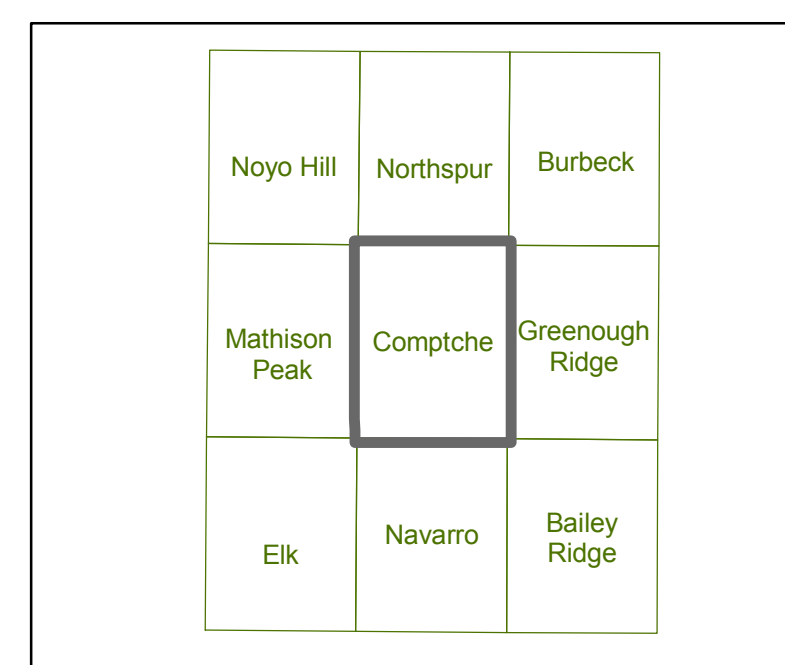
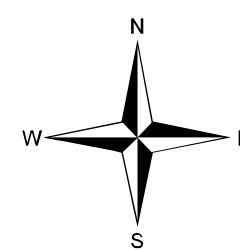
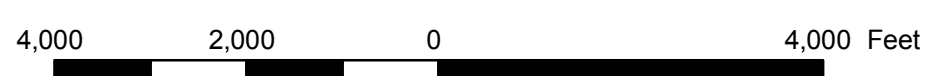


- Subterranean Flow
