## Summary

On March 25, 2010, Kim Nguyen and Ken Hodge (the Louis Berger Group), the FERC staff had a telephone conversation with Ms. Ginger Gillin of GEI Consultants (engineering consultant for Eagle Crest) to clarify the average annual generation and average annual pumping energy filed with the license application on June 23, 2009.

Ms. Gillin called back on March 29, 2010 to confirm that the average annual generation is 4,308 gigawatt-hours (GWh) while the pumping energy should be 5,744 GWh, not 3,500 GWh as stated in the license application.
