**Project Title:** Water Supply Project (Project)

**Project Applicant:** Lewiston Community Services District (LCSD)


**Project Location (include county):** In the vicinity of Lewiston, CA; Trinity County. The Project is found on the Lewiston, California 7.5 U.S. Geological Survey quadrangle Township 33N; Range 8W; Sections 17, 18, and 20; Mount Diablo Base & Meridian.

**Project Description:** LCSD proposes to relocate its infiltration gallery (formerly owned and operated by the Lewiston Valley Water Company) to a location approximately 2,800 feet downstream of the existing intake in Lewiston, California. The proposed infiltration gallery would be constructed in a large gravel bar built in August 2008 as part of the United States Bureau of Reclamation's Trinity River Restoration Program. Water would be piped from the infiltration gallery to a new raw water pump station and, from there, into a 2,675-foot long raw water pipeline that leads to LCSD's existing water treatment plant (WTP). There would be no modifications to the existing WTP.
