**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Upper North Fork Feather River (UNFFR) Hydroelectric Project consists of several facilities, which include Lake Almanor, Butt Valley Reservoir, three dams which impound water on the North Fork Feather River, five powerhouses, and three bypassed stream reaches. In accordance with the Federal Power Act, Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) submitted an application to relicense the UNFFR Project with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission on October 23, 2002. Prior to the issuance of a new license, PG&E must obtain a Clean Water Act (CWA) section 401 water quality certification that the project will be in compliance with the specified provisions of the CWA (33 U.S.C. § 1341 et seq.), including State water quality standards as contained in the applicable water quality control plan. Issuance of a water quality certification is subject to the California Environmental Quality Act.
